Suggested Activities:

Explore the area with absolute privacy, tranquility, and exclusive access to the 16,000-hectare nature reserve property. Amazing rock formations abound.

The property is part of the Cape Floral Kingdom, known as one of the 34 internationally recognized “biodiversity hotspots,” which provides endless opportunities for botany exploration. It is also conveniently located close to the spots where the sought-after Cinnamon-breasted Warbler and Cape Eagle Owl may be found.

The Cederberg is renowned for its clear and remarkable night skies that remain untouched by manmade light pollution. It is frequently listed as one of the top places in South Africa, and in the world, for Southern Hemisphere stargazing. The ideal place to dream under a sky full of immeasurable twinkling stars, to learn about the cosmos, and to create night-time star photography. We hope to have an astronomer with us and the opportunity to observe through a telescope.
